

Red Squirrel Sightings – November 2019

General –

The number of sightings this month is down on the previous month and therefore remains low, but those that have been reported are all described as being in good health.

No reports of greys and/or S/Pox cases.

Following on from Reds having been seen in very close proximity to the road at Hopper Hill a road sign has now been erected.

Road Deaths – No Reports

Cat Attacks - none reported

Greys shot this year in parish = 4 (and x1 road death)

Reds with S/pox shot this year in parish = 4

General – few sightings – Flass remains most likely place to see any along with Morland Bank Wood

Green Ends – 3rd - red with black tail, white breast, seen in the garden for the last two days.

Lyvennet Bank – still taking from the feeder, can be every day or will go 4-5 days with nothing taken.
Rare sightings in Flass Wood behind.

Flass - sightings are irregular - none seen for a while come month's end.
Most seen at the same time being two.

Other Sightings:

Start of Month – most mornings in proximity to road at northern edge of Morland Bank Wood and on-going throughout the month.

14th - Judith Cove's – in garden

17th - **Linden House** - Large healthy looking one in back garden.
